

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

JUST IN CASE YOU DON'T KNOW . . .

This is a wonderful, creative way to support the Keen Age Center. It's called the **Legacy Quilt II**. Legacy Quilt I was completed several years ago and has been displayed at the Center. WHAT DO YOU NEED TO KNOW?

PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENT FREEZE

This program allows a qualified senior citizen to have your home's assessed value "frozen' at a base year value to prevent increases due to inflation. This does NOT mean that your property taxes will not increase because other factors affect your tax bill.

To qualify you must:

- Be 65
- Have household income less than \$55,000
- Have lived in your home for at least 1 year
- Own the property
- Have the property tax bill in your name

You must reapply every year with proof of your household's annual income. The deadline for filing is November 1, 2013. Please contact your Outreach Counselor, Janet, Susan, or Joanne for an appointment. 815-544-9893.

STATE ANNOUNCES NEW PROGRAM

The State of Illinois has replaced the old Circuit Breaker program with a new plan called the **Benefit Access Program**. The benefits now available are:

- Seniors Free Transit Ride and Persons with Disabilities Free Transit Ride
- Secretary of State License Plate Discount

To qualify you must:

- Be 65 or older by Dec. 31 of the current year or be 16 or older and totally
- Be a resident of IL when you file the application
- Have 2012 income less than
 - \$27,610 for a 1 person household
 - \$36,635 for a 2 person household

FARMERS' MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM



The purpose of this program is to provide fresh fruits and vegetables to seniors, as well as, expand awareness and use of local farmers' markets. To qualify you must:

- Be at least 60 years old
- Qualify according to your household's gross income
 - Less than \$1,722/month for 1 person
 - Less than \$2,332/month for 2 people
- If you qualify, you will receive a coupon book worth \$21 that can only be used at the farmers' market. Our local market is located in the Dodge Lanes Bowling parking lot on Saturdays from 9 am to 1 pm. Your coupons may be used until October 31st. The \$2 fee covers the cost of the picture and plastic ID card.

Prairie State Legal Services, a nonprofit organization that has offered legal help in noncriminal matters for low income persons and older adults (60 and over) for more than 34 years, is expanding its services to Boone County. The program will focus its services on aiding older adults who are in the greatest social & economic need. Services include: Aiding nursing home residents with disputes regarding discharge or care; legal help for homebound seniors who are facing the loss of services needed to remain safe in the community; legal representation of older adults who have been abused or exploited by others; legal counsel for older adults who have difficulties making ends meet because of debts, including medical debts, denials of government income benefits, and many other problems. The receptionist at the Boone County Council on Aging (815-544-9893) will forward referrals to Prairie State Legal Services. Someone from that office will contact you to schedule an appointment at the Keen Age Center.

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
